

Fall 2025 Grade 4 Reading Growth Assessment

In the 2025-2026 school year, students in Virginia public schools will take growth assessments in Grades 3-8 Reading and Mathematics. Legislation passed in the 2021 Virginia General Assembly ([HB2027](#) and [SB1357](#)) requires growth assessments be administered to students once in the fall and once in the winter (mid-year). In addition to the growth assessments, the Standards of Learning (SOL) tests for Grades 3-8 Reading and Mathematics will continue to be administered. Please note the fall growth assessment for Grade 4 is based on Grade 3 content. This is intended to ensure students are administered test questions on the fall growth assessments based on content taught during the previous school year. Test items at or below a student’s grade level may be delivered online via the computer adaptive algorithm as appropriate for the student. The online fall growth assessment for Grade 4 will begin with questions that assess either Grade 3 or Grade 2 English SOL, and the overall test may include test items that assess Grade 2, Grade 3, or Grade 4 English SOL. Students who meet the criteria for needing a paper test will receive Grade 3 test items.

**Vocabulary development and word analysis* will be tested with both literary and informational texts.

**A passage set is a set of items associated with a single text, a single text and companion graphic with description, or a pair of texts. All reading passage sets are determined *grade-level appropriate* by a committee of Virginia educators prior to administration on the Reading SOL tests, with consideration to reading load. *Students receive no more than one pair of texts per test administration in Grades 3-8.* All Reading SOL content is tested within a passage set and no longer in standalone items.
